Explainer: Introduction to the Bedouin Community in the Negev



This source sheet companion lists the sources used in the Explainer, offers resources for further learning, and shares additional information. We hope you take advantage of these sources to learn more about the Bedouin Community in the Negev and to support your efforts to educate others.

Notes on the numbers and sources used to create the Explainer

Most of the statistics come from the Israeli Central Bureau of Statistics (CBS) and the Knesset Research and Information Center (RIC). These reports often group Bedouin citizens into the general "Arab" category or place them together with Bedouin citizens from the Galilee and central Israel. This broad categorization obscures the unique socio-economic characteristics and challenges of Negev Bedouin. Some of the data in this explainer comes from the Dedicated Research Database on the Bedouin of the Negev at Ben-Gurion University, which may present outdated information due to limited funding.

This lack of comprehensive data makes it challenging to identify the specific needs and characteristics of different Bedouin populations. Creating further difficulties, since Negev Bedouin represent only 3.5% of Israel's population the number of respondents in surveys is often insufficient to yield reliable information.

As a result of these discrepancies and the challenges in data collection and analysis, the statistics provided should be viewed as approximations. These issues underscore the difficulties in effectively planning for Bedouin communities in Israel and understanding their distinct experiences as a subgroup within the larger Arab minority.

6. Islam is central to Bedouin life and significantly influences practices and traditions. Politically and socially, Bedouin are part of Israel's Arab minority, holding full Israeli citizenship and participating in the country's society, economy, and politics. Additionally, similar to many Arab citizens, many Negev Bedouin have strong connections to the broader Palestinian community, including deep familial ties to the West Bank and Gaza, and may include Palestinian as an important aspect of their national identity.

In the first years of the state, Bedouin settlements were concentrated in the Siyag region, covering some 10% of the region, where most remain to this day. Other localities were built before a 1965 Planning and Construction Law, which re-zoned most of the Negev as agricultural, making many homes retroactively illegal. There have been several plans attempting to settle the state-community claims over the land.
